 this my Last will and testament
 I give and Bequith unto my Dearly and well BE-
 loved son James my whole Right of the Improvement
 we Live on
 I give and Bequith unto my Dearly and well Belov'd
 son Thomas my Large Ribell and the new Chest
 I give and Bequith unto my Dearly and well Belov'd
 Daughter margret my Chest: and all the Remains
 of my Estate I order and ordain to be sold at publick
 vendow and Equily divided amongst my Six Children
 and my Grand Daughter Elizabeth turn over

Unto James M^r Broom and Thomas margret Janet
 Elizabeth and mary M^r Broom and aliso ~~my~~ my
 Grand Daughter Elizabeth Boggs and aliso what moneys
 is in the house and all my Bonds and 1300^l Debts
 notes and other Demands I order and ordain aliso to
 be Equily divided amongst the aforesaid seven
 Heirs and I do hereby utterly Disallow Revoke and
 Rescind all and Every other former testaments wills
 Legacies and Executors by me in any ways
 Before this time made willed and Bequithed
 Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be
 my Last will and testament in witness where of
 I have set my hand and Seal the Day and
 Year above written: memorandam that before
 signed or sealed I give and Bequith unto
 my Grand son John Broom
