Itim I Do Likwife Conftitute make and ordain my Dearly Beloved Sones James McBroom and thomas McBroom Sole Executors of this my last will and teftment.

Itim I give and Bequith unto my Dearly and well Beloved Son James my whole Right of the Improvement we Live on

Itim I Give and Beqith unto my Dearly and well Beloved son thomas my Large Bibell an the new Chift Itim I Give and Bequith unto my Dearly and well Beloved Daughter Margre my Chift and all the Remeander of my Eftate I order and ordain to be Sold at publick vandew and Equly Devided amongft my Six Childring and my Grand Daughter Elifabath Unto James McBroom and thomas Margret Janet Elifabat and Mary McBroom and allfo my Grand Daughter Elifabath Boges and allfo what moneys is in the hous and all my Bonds and Book Debets notes and other Demands I order and ordain allfo to Be Equly Devidd amongft the aforfaid feven Heirs and I do hearby utterly Difallow Revock and Difannul all and Every other former teftments wills Legacies and Executors By me in any ways Before this time named willed and Bequithed Ratifying and Confirming this and no oth to be my laft will and teftment In Wittnefs whereof I have Set my hand and Seall th Day and year above written: Memmerandam-that Before figned or fealed I Give and Bequeth unto my Grandson John Rea my goon
